HEAD COACH MARK NOLAN



Coach Mark Nolan is now in his 5th season as the Head Coach at Trabuco Hills, leading the Mustangs to the CIF Southern Section Semifinals in his first season with the Mustangs. Coach Nolan believes in the principles of a holistic education, which includes the development of the total person and that football is a great vehicle to make a lifelong impact on a young person.

Coach Mark Nolan earned his Master's Degree in Education from Willamette University while simultaneously coaching the defensive line ('95) and defensive backs ('96). Furthermore, Coach Nolan received his bachelor's degree in History from Willamette University in 1995, where he lettered four seasons as a defensive back and earned all-conference honors as a junior and senior. Mark also lettered four times in track (sprints and relays) and is a record holder to this day.

After Willamette University, Mark moved on to Gilbert High School (AZ) and was an Assistant Varsity Coach for both football and track from 1997-2002. While at Gilbert, Coach Nolan coordinated the special teams. He also won Teacher of the Year accolades and was runner up for a second time. Coach Nolan then spent the 2003-2005 seasons at Brophy College Preparatory, a Jesuit Institution. The Brophy Broncos won the state championship for Class 5A in the 2005 season. Coach Nolan was the Defensive Coordinator and Head Track Coach during his time at Brophy, After Brophy, Mark was the Director of Recruiting for University of Colorado for three seasons (2006-2008). At CU, they signed a Nationally Ranked Top 15 recruiting class and Coach Nolan was able to work with the DB's for one season and the Offensive Line for two years. Mark was at Regis Jesuit, in Denver for the 2009-2014 seasons, where he served as Head Football Coach and Offensive Coordinator, with three of the top five all time scoring offenses in the school's 90 year history occurring during his tenure. While at Regis Jesuit, Mark also served as Strength and Conditioning Coordinator and taught in both PE and Social Studies departments. In 2010-2011, Mark was awarded Teacher of the Year at Regis Jesuit. In 2015-2016, Mark served as Head Football Coach and Defensive Coordinator at Notre Dame Prep while he was also teaching in both PE and Social Studies. In 2017, Mark was Defensive Analyst for the UC Davis Aggies in California. In 2018, Mark was back in AZ as the DC for the Chaparral Firebirds while he was teaching in both Social Studies and PE. The Firebirds posted 2 of the top 10 leading tacklers in the state of AZ in 2018.

During his career, Coach Nolan has received seven (7) Coach of the Year Awards as well as being a PCA finalist. Over 3 decades, Mark Nolan has coached several different All-Conference and All-State players as well as collegiately recruited several players that are currently playing in the NFL. These numbers are as follows: 8 into Special Forces, 22 into the NFL for various lengths of time, and as a head coach, over 70 placed into college football programs. Mark Nolan has been married to his wife, Aspen, since 1997. They have three children – a daughter and two sons. Mark attends and actively serves in a church near his home.





Michael Talafus - Varsity/JV Offensive Line

Coach Talafus is a 2012 Trabuco Hills alumnus and a D1 offensive lineman who played for San Jose State University from 2012-2016. He played all positions on the O-Line during his college career but saw most action at center. Coach Talafus feels very fortunate to have been coached by three O-Line coaches at SJSU, who all moved on to coach in the NFL. Adam Stenavich (Green Bay Packers O-Line Coach), Hank Fraley (Detroit Lions Assistant O-Line Coach; Center for Eagles in Super Bowl XXXIX), and Keith Carter (Tennessee Titans O-Line Coach).



Joe Silvey – Varsity Defensive Coordinator

Coach Silvey returns to the Mustang football staff this season to coordinate the defense. Over 29 seasons in Orange and San Diego counties, the teams on which he has coached have appeared in eight CIF championship games and captured six titles (including the most recent Trabuco Hills championship in 2014). Players he has coached have continued their careers at schools such as Vanderbilt, Colorado, San Jose State, BYU, Harvard, Dartmouth, Trinity, Air Force, Villanova, and UC Davis.

Coach Silvey played linebacker at Mater Dei High School in Santa Ana and continued his education at Princeton University in New Jersey. He currently teaches sophomores and juniors as a member of the English Department at Trabuco Hills. He and his wife, Jennifer have raised three children together and reside in Aliso Viejo.



Derick Milgrim – Varsity Offensive Coordinator/ Wide Receivers

Coach Milgrim returns for his fifth year on the Mustang Football Staff, and his third year as the offensive coordinator. He will continue to work with the Wide Receivers and the JV team as well. He has been coaching high school football since 1998, including stops at Claremont, Don Lugo, Laguna Creek, and Cosumnes Oaks High Schools, where he was part of 10 League Championships and 17 playoff appearances. He has served as Head Freshman and JV Coach, varsity assistant coach working with QB's, RB's and WR's, and Head Varsity Coach from 2014 – 2018 at Cosumnes Oaks HS in Elk Grove, CA. Players he has coached have continued their careers at schools such as UCLA, UC Berkeley, Oregon, Washington, Oregon State, Duke, Nevada Reno, UNLV, Air Force Academy, San Diego State, Utah State, Cal Poly SLO, Sacramento State, UC Davis, Weber State, Idaho State, Montana State, and Idaho.

Coach Milgrim played Quarterback at Claremont High School and continued his education and athletic career at The University of Kansas, before transferring and graduating from Claremont McKenna College. He later received his teaching credential and Master's in Education from the University of La Verne. He currently teaches English here at Trabuco Hills and feels very fortunate to get to work on the same campus as his wife Melissa. Together they are kept busy by their daughter Madison.



Andrew Nielsen - Varsity Safeties

Coach Nielsen will be entering his first year as a coach and English Teacher at THHS this school year. Prior to coaching and teaching at THHS, he worked at Hart High School as an English teacher for three years and an assistant coach on the football team for two seasons. At Hart, Coach Nielsen worked with defensive backs, receivers, and specialists on the varsity football team. Additionally, he attended Hart High School as a student and participated in the football program for all four years. As a player, Coach Nielsen started for the CIF SS Northern Division Championship team in 2013, while also earning All-League, All-CIF, and All-State honors as a K/P from 2013-2015. He also currently holds three separate records at Hart High School, including Career PATs (156), Career Field Goals (18), and Longest Field Goal (54 yards). After high school, he earned an undergraduate degree at UCLA before completing a teaching credential program at CSUN.

Coach Nielsen is excited to integrate himself as a valuable member of the THHS community both as a coach and teacher. He will be teaching ninth and eleventh graders as a member of the THHS English Department this year. He currently resides with his wife, Sawyer, in Lake Forest.



Taylor Schad – Varsity Defensive Line/JV Head Coach, Defensive Coordinator/Defensive Line

Coach Schad grew up in small town Oregon and played multiple sports in high school. After graduating Cascade High School, Coach Schad played college football at Pacific in Forest Grove, Oregon, where he earned his undergraduate degree. Coach Schad was hired in 2019 to join our Science Dept and teach Physics here at THHS. Along with coaching the Defensive Line for the Mustangs, Coach Schad also coaches the Shot and Discus for the Boys Track Team.



Jim Cavallo - Varsity Cornerbacks/JV Defensive Backs

Coach Cavallo is entering his 45th season of football this fall having played high school, college and professionally. Jim played WR/DB/K/P at Weymouth High School in Massachusetts, then Northeastern University in Boston, where he played WR/DB and signed with the Tampa Bay Buccaneers. He went on to play in the NFL Europe and MLFS Minor League football system.

Jim has three children - James, Allison and Joseph, all playing sports in college. Jim has spent the last 17 years coaching in various roles at Duxbury High School, MA, where he was a WR/DB/OL Coach, Scout and Data Analytics, before coming to Trabuco Hills. Along with coaching 17 years, he was part of 5 state championships, 2 second place finishes and 15 league titles.



Luke Herzog – Varsity Tight Ends/JV Offensive Coordinator, Tight Ends/Special Teams

This will be Coach Herzog's 3rd season as the Varsity Tight End's Coach for our Trabuco Mustangs, and his 2nd season as the Junior Varsity Offensive Coordinator. Coach Herzog grew up in Irvine where he competed in multiple sports including Football, Wrestling, and Volleyball for Northwood High School. After graduating from Northwood, Coach Herzog served in the United States Marine Corps from 2010-2015, and deployed to Afghanistan in 2012 in support of Operation Enduring Freedom. In 2022, Coach Herzog graduated from Western Governors University with a Bachelor of Science in Science Education, and this is going to be his 2nd year teaching Living Earth Science.



Alex Bridgford - Varsity/JV Quarterbacks

Alex is from Mission Viejo and is in his 3rd season coaching QB's for the Mustangs. He played youth football for the Mission Viejo Cowboys, in high school at Mission Viejo High School, and in college at both University of Redlands and USC. After college, he played one season in Europe and won the 2017 Swiss National Championship with the Luzern Lions. He has been doing private/group training for the last 7 years around Orange County. JT Ayers - Speed Trainer

Coach JT Ayers is a 3-time Orange County Track Coach of the Year (2013, 2016, 2020) and is entering his 19th year of coaching Track and Field. Coach Ayers led his team at Orange Lutheran High School to its first CIF Division 3 Championship in 2013. After that, he took over at his Alma Mater, Trabuco Hills High School, as Head Coach of the boy's team in 2014. Since then, his athletes have broken 43 grade levels and 15 school records, 3 All-Time Orange County Records, and the team has been ranked #1 in Orange County 6 different years (2015, 2016, 2018, 2020, 2021, 2023).

This is Coach Ayers first year back coaching football since 2010 where he coached defensive backs at Trabuco. During his tenure the Mustangs reached 2 CIF Championship games and the coaching staff was selected as Coaches of the Year and coached in the 2009 OC South vs North All-Star Game. Coach Ayers received his B.A. in History from Cal Poly San Luis Obispo, and his Teaching Credential and Masters in Coaching and Athletic Administration from Concordia University, Irvine. He is currently running a speed developed business, Coach Ayers Performance - www.coachayers.com - for youth and high school athletes, has published work in (SimpliFaster.com/articles/mass-specific-force-lifting-sprinters), and teaches in the Social Studies Department (freshman football class) at Trabuco as well. MUSTANG FRESHMAN COACHES



Matthew Bowman - Freshman Defensive Coordinator/ Assistant Offensive Line, Defensive Line

This year will be the 18th year Coach Bowman has been coaching football. He began his coaching career at his alma mater, McFarland High School (CA), where he played QB and DB. After 2 years he moved on to Orange Lutheran for I year where he coached DBs under legendary coach Jim Kunau. He then moved on to coach special teams and DBs for the inaugural season of Crean Lutheran High School in Irvine. Coach Bowman was on staff at Crean Lutheran for 9 years, serving in various capacities; the last 6 years as Defensive Coordinator. In his 6 years as DC, the Saints experienced their greatest success in program history. In 2015, the Saints were CIF Semi-Finalists before losing to eventual champions SVC. In 3 playoff games, Coach Bowman's defense only allowed 12 points per game.

In 2016, Coach Bowman was promoted to Head Coach of Crean Lutheran. He led the Saints to 2 winning seasons, compiling a 13-8 record, making the playoffs in his second season, before losing to eventual CIF champions Katella. Coach Bowman's defense produced the Academy League Player of the Year three years in a row.

Coach Bowman joined the Mustangs staff as the Defensive Backs Coach and Special Team Coordinator in 2018. This year, he will serve as the Freshmen Defensive Coordinator. He teaches Math on staff at Trabuco Hills as well. He and his wife Kimberly have 3 wonderful children. They reside in Laguna Hills and enjoy reading Theology and spending time outdoors.
